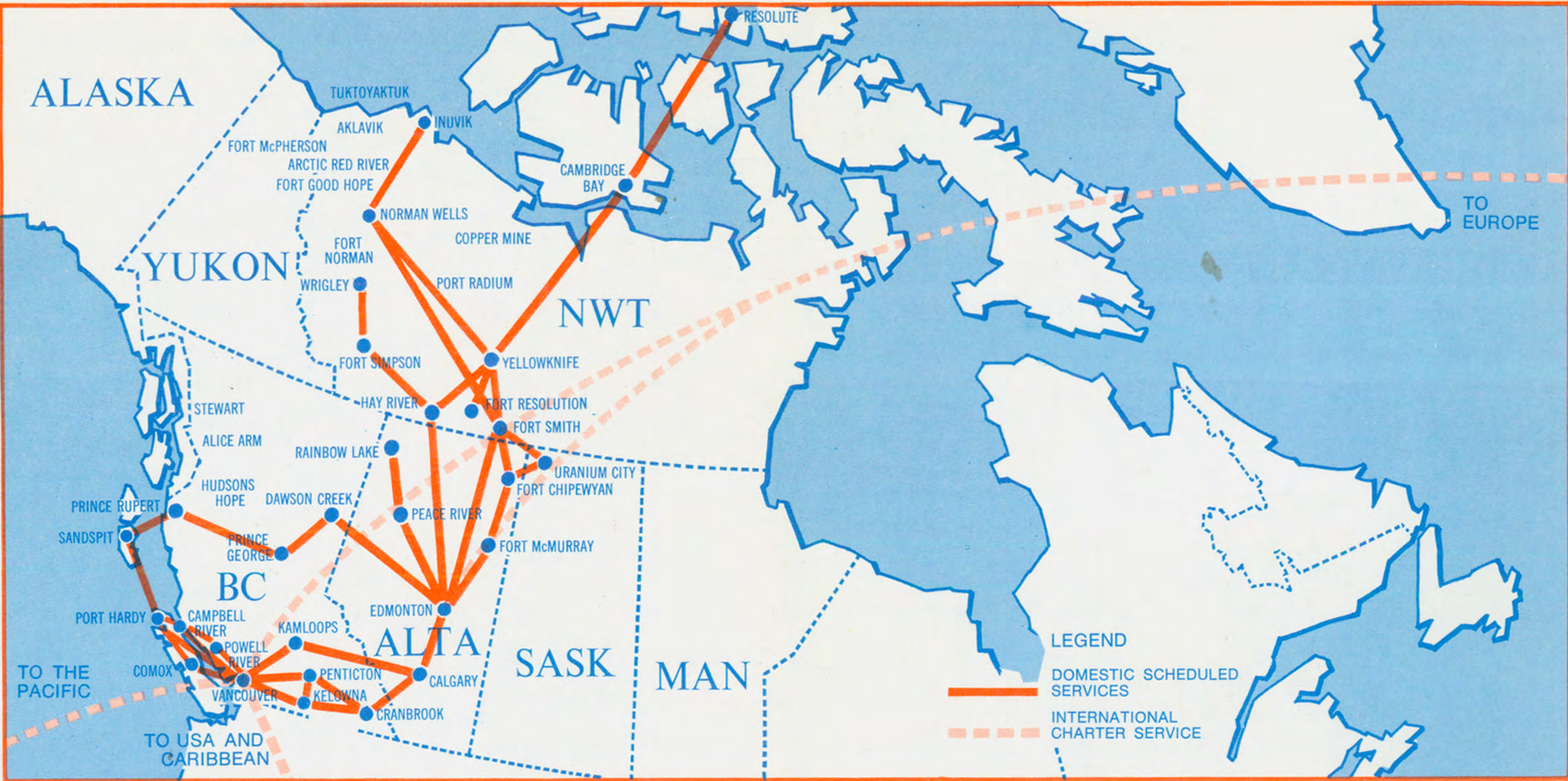

GENERAL INFORMATION

GENERAL—Fares schedules and all other information published herein are subject to Tariff Regulations and change without notice. Carrier will not be responsible for damages resulting from failure of planes to depart or arrive at times stated herein. Fares quoted are in Canadian currency.

BAGGAGE AND PERSONAL PROPERTY ALLOWANCES—Baggage will be carried on any full fare ticket up to a maximum of 44 pounds. Baggage or other personal property in excess of 44 pounds will be charged for at current tariff rates. Excess baggage will be accepted subject to aircraft weight and space limitations.

LIABILITY of the carrier for loss of, or damage to, or any delay in the delivery of personal property, including baggage, is limited to the amount of \$100.00 per ticket.

CONTENTS shall consist only of wearing apparel, non-liquid toilet articles and similar effects necessary and appropriate for the use of the passenger for the purpose of the journey and not intended for other persons or for sale. Money, jewelry, silverware, samples, negotiable paper, securities and similar valuables or business documents will not be carried except on the understanding that the Carrier shall not be liable for loss, damage, or delay of such articles. Assembled firearms, explosives, corrosives, radioactive material, matches, and other articles which may be easily ignited will not be carried.

IN CABIN—Passengers may carry BRIEF CASES, PORTABLE TYPEWRITERS, BABY KITS (except bassinets) and similar articles in the cabin, but no more than can be stowed under the passenger seat. These articles MUST BE WEIGHED AS BAGGAGE AND BE INCLUDED IN THE TOTAL WEIGHT. Ladies' handbags and pocketbooks, overcoats and wraps, foot rugs, umbrellas, and walking sticks, small cameras, binoculars and a reasonable amount of reading material may be carried in the cabin.

CHILDREN under two years of age for whom seats are reserved and children two years of age and under twelve years of age will be charged one-half of the full normal adult fare. ONE child under two years of age and not occupying a seat, will be carried free with each adult fare.

GROUND TRANSPORTATION—PWA does not operate any ground transportation services. PWA neither assumes nor is under any liability of any nature with respect to ground transportation services or the acts or omissions of the ground transportation operators.

PASSENGERS PROCEEDING BY PRIVATE CONVEYANCE SHOULD BE AT THE AIRPORT TO ALLOW TWENTY MINUTES FOR COMPLETION OF CHECK-IN PROCEDURES. DEPARTURES WILL NOT BE DELAYED TO ACCOMMODATE LATE ARRIVING PASSENGERS.

RESERVATIONS will be cancelled by PWA unless tickets are purchased at the time specified by the Company. Reservations for return flights, stopover flights and flights originating at a point other than where the reservation is booked, will be cancelled unless re-confirmed by passengers with PWA at least 6 hours prior to departure if the flight is scheduled to depart after 12:00 noon or by 4:00 p.m. local time on the day before departure if the flight is scheduled to depart before 12:00 noon.

The Company reserves the right to refuse or cancel reservations before passage or en route whenever such action is deemed advisable or necessary.
