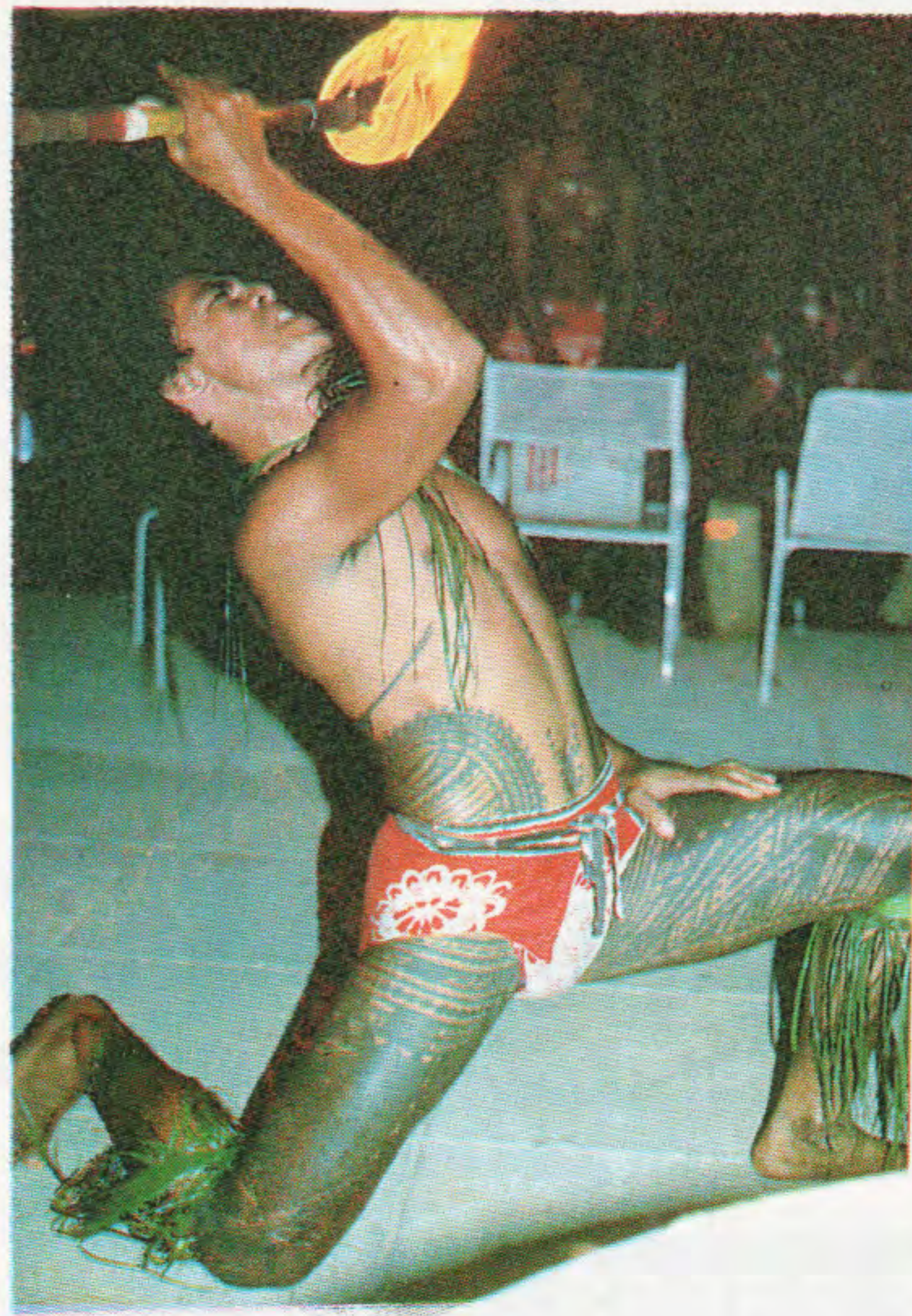

GENERAL INFORMATION FOR PASSENGERS

Conditions of Carriage and Regulations

The carriage of passengers, baggage and cargo on Air Pacific is subject to the Contract of Carriage and Regulations which may be seen upon request at any Air Pacific Sales Office. The conditions of this Contract are also printed in your ticket.

Flight Schedules

The flights shown in this timetable are those scheduled by Air Pacific at the time of printing. Only the most direct connections between listed cities are shown.

Information on direct connections and voluntary stopovers en-route can be obtained from Air Pacific or your Travel Agent.

Reservations

Passenger reservations may be made by phone or in person with any Air Pacific Reservations Sales Section, Air Pacific Passenger Sales Office or your Travel Agent.

Please reserve your seats as far in advance as possible.

Requests For Specific Seats

Reservations of specific seats in economy class cannot be guaranteed although every effort will be made to meet passengers requirements.

Smoking

Smoking is restricted on all Domestic flights. 'Smoking/No Smoking' zones are designated on all international flights. Requests for seating in these areas may be made at the time of the booking or at check-in.

Change in Booking

If you have to cancel or change your reservations please let Air Pacific or your Travel Agent know as soon as possible.

Reconfirmations

If you are continuing your journey on Air Pacific, after coming off another international flight, please telephone us as soon as possible so that your departure time could be rechecked and reconfirmed.

Failure to reconfirm within 72 hours may result in cancellation of your reservations.

Sick, Expectant Mothers and Invalid Passengers

Air Pacific's Medical Officer will advise on applications for the carriage of sick and invalid passengers, including stretcher cases and expectant mothers.

It is therefore important that you let Air Pacific or your Travel Agent know of your condition when making reservations.

Travel Documents

Before you start your journey check to be sure all your documents — visas, passport, vaccination certificates, etc — are in order. All airlines including Air Pacific reserve the right to refuse carriage to passengers whose travel documents are not in order. Air Pacific or your Travel Agent will be glad to advise on entry requirements for destinations abroad.

Currency

Most Governments restrict the amount of currency which may be taken into or out of their countries. The carriage of notes or coinage is particularly restricted. We recommend that you carry your main funds in the form of Travellers' Cheques.

Credit Cards

Air Pacific will honour the following credit cards for travel on its Domestic and International services: Universal Air Travel Plan, American Express, Diners Club, Carte Blanche, Visa and Master Charge.

Inflight Catering

Meals, alcoholic beverages and soft drinks are served with the compliments of Air Pacific.

Special meal service is available for passengers on special diet. Special meals for children who cannot eat adult meals can also be arranged. Please let Air Pacific or your Travel Agent know of your requirements when making bookings.

Latest Check-in Time

The latest airport check-in time is indicated on your ticket. Passengers who arrive after this time risk losing their flight reservations.

The formalities and preparation essential to every flight make it necessary to close passenger handling formalities in good time. We cannot delay flights for passengers who arrive late.

Airport Services

Air Pacific will do all possible to make your flight an enjoyable one. Our Airport Services personnel or our handling agents are on duty at all major airports, in arrival halls and departure lounges. They will be pleased to assist you at check-in, and through airline and governmental formalities.

Baggage

Your baggage should contain personal effects only.

Restricted Articles

Carriage of the following articles in passenger baggage or in the aircraft cabin is prohibited:—

1. Explosives, munitions, fireworks and flares;
2. Compressed gases (flammable, non-flammable and poisonous), such as camping gas;
3. Flammable liquids (such as lighter or heating fuels, and liquids which are easily ignited);
4. Flammable solids — matches and articles which are easily ignited;
5. Oxidising materials (such as bleaching powder and peroxides);
6. Poisons;
7. Radioactive materials;
8. Corrosive materials (such as acids, alkalis, wet cell batteries and mercury);
9. Other dangerous goods (such as magnetised materials) as listed in the IATA Manual.

For full details consult Air Pacific or your Travel Agent.

Free Baggage Allowance

A free allowance for each passenger aged 2 years or more is available on all Air Pacific services as follows:

All adults and children paying 50% or more of the adult fare, are entitled to a free baggage allowance. Infants paying 10% of the adult fare are not entitled to any free baggage allowance.

The free allowances are determined by route and class of fares paid.

Special allowances apply to the carriage of infants baggage and some unusual baggage items such as collapsible wheelchairs and bassinets.

Air Pacific or your Travel Agent will be glad to give you more details.

Pooling Baggage

If you are travelling in a party you may pool your baggage with that of others and take advantage of the collective free baggage allowance, provided all members of the group report for travel (with baggage) at the same time and place, and are also travelling as one party to a common destination on the same flight.

Excess Baggage

1. *International Journeys* (other than to/from USA, US Territories and Canada) —
—a charge of 1% of the one-way first class fare between the points concerned for each kilogram in excess of the free allowance will be charged.
2. *To/from USA, US Territories and Canada* — A standard charge will be levied for each additional and/or oversize piece exceeding the free allowances. Details may be obtained from any Air Pacific Office.

3. **Domestic Services**—a charge based on the applicable adult fare for the journey will be levied for the weight exceeding the free allowance. Details may be obtained from any Air Pacific Office.

Unaccompanied Baggage

Air Pacific offers special facilities on all international services (except to/from USA) whereby overweight baggage consisting of personal wearing apparel and personal articles may be carried at rates considered lower than either the normal Excess Baggage or Cargo rates. Such baggage will not necessarily travel on the same aircraft as yourself. To qualify for this concession the baggage should be delivered to an Air Cargo depot before you travel, and must be cleared as cargo at your destination. You will be required to show your airline tickets for verification by the accepting cargo officers.

Other details of this facility can be obtained at any Air Pacific Office.

Cabin Baggage

A free allowance for each passenger aged 2 years or more is available on all Air Pacific service as follows:

International and Domestic journeys—One bag not exceeding the following dimension—length 56 cm (22 in) width 23 cm (9 in) height 36 cm (14 in). In addition to the free allowance, personal articles such as an overcoat, umbrella, handbag, purse, camera, binoculars and a reasonable amount of reading materials for the flight may be carried into the aircraft cabin.

Details for carriage of special items for infants can be obtained from any Air Pacific Office.

In the interests of safety and where locking overhead bins are not fitted in the aircraft, such items of cabin baggage must not be placed in the hat rack, but must be capable of being stowed under the passenger's seat. All items being carried by the passenger must be presented at the acceptance counter at check-in time, as any article that is too bulky must be processed as checked baggage and stowed in the aircraft hold. When this is necessary and the free checked allowance is exceeded, the appropriate excess baggage rates will be charged.

SMALL PACKAGE INTERNATIONAL (SPI)

There is an airport to airport urgent small package service (up to 32kgs and is subject to certain conditions) provided by Air Pacific in association with United Airlines, Pan Am, Ansett NZ and Eagle Air covering North America, Europe, Australia, New Zealand and Pacific Countries.

Sophisticated shippers recognise that SPI is a premium product costing not much more than General cargo rates but geared to speed urgent shipments through congested routes. Contact your nearest Air Pacific Cargo Office for further information.

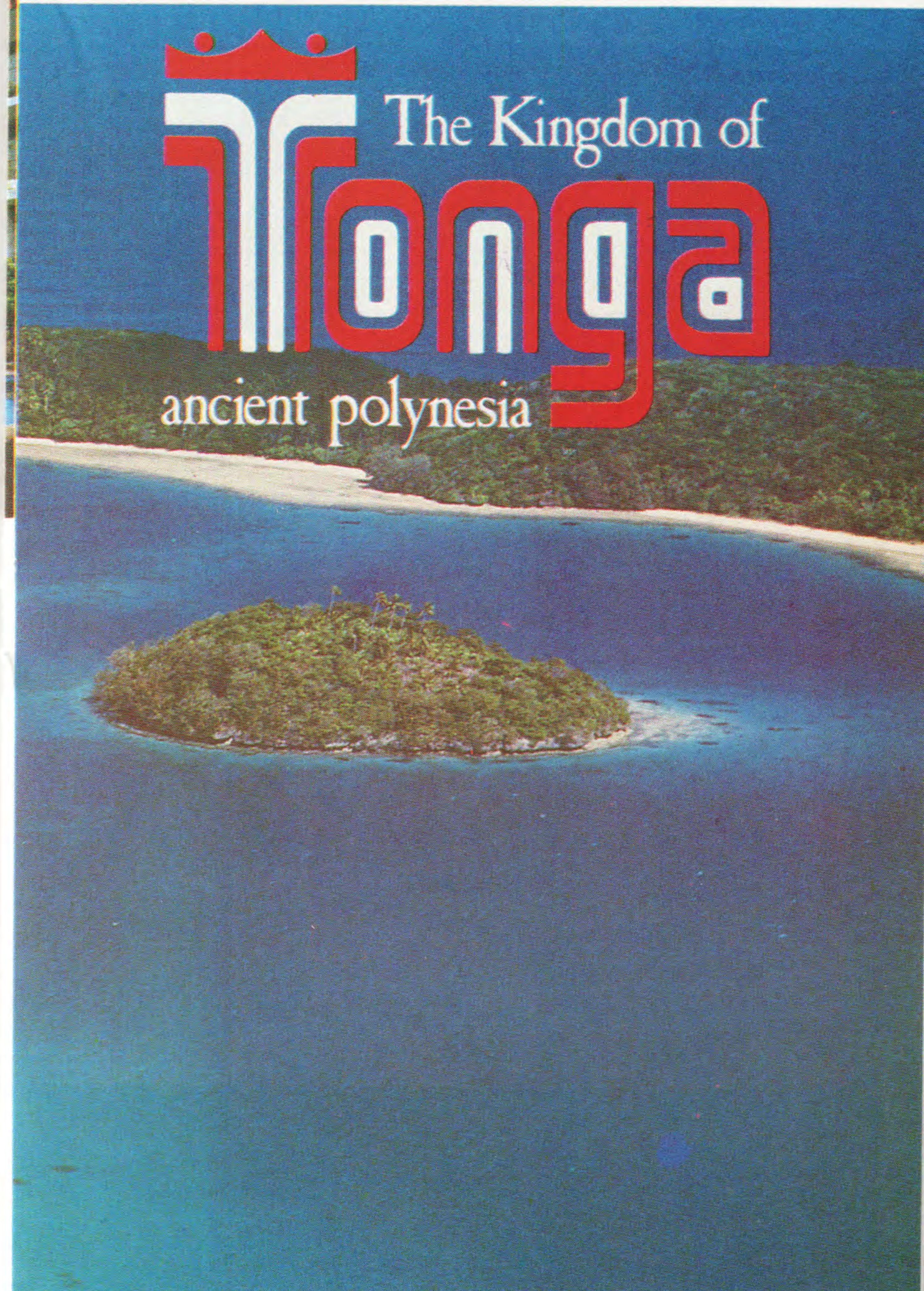

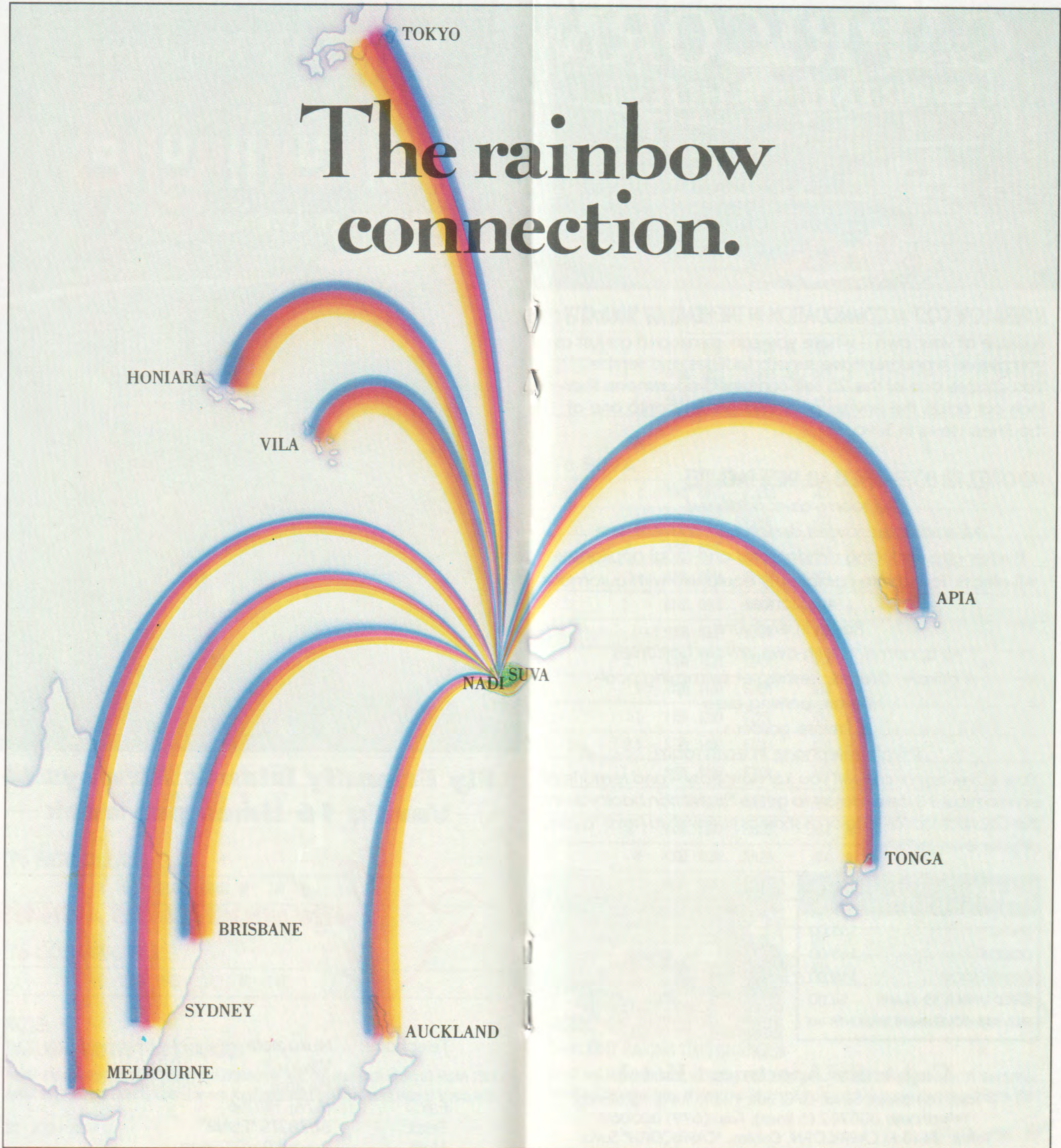

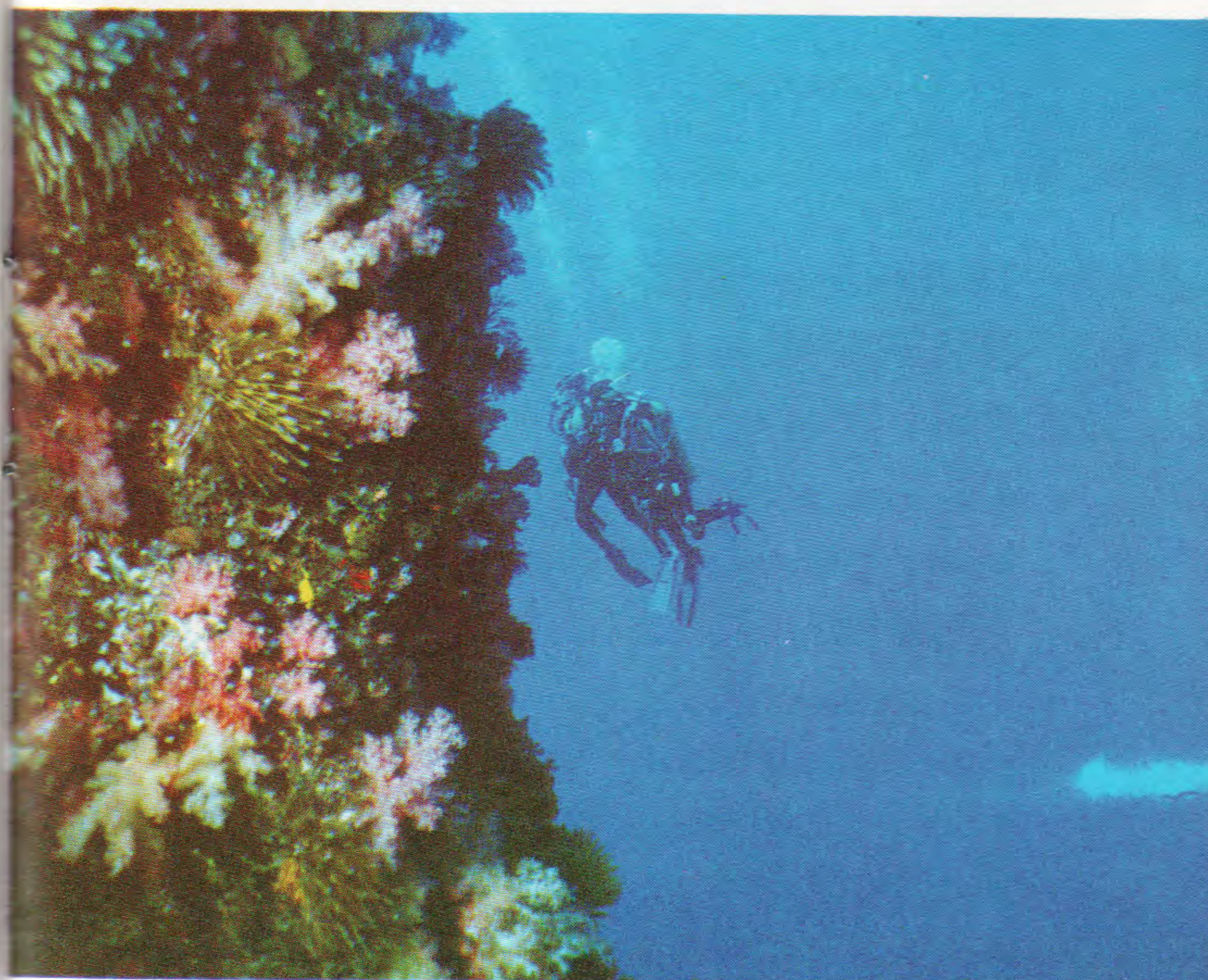

- Use your eyes and ears while in an airport or onboard an aircraft. Report anything you see or hear that you think is suspicious to the Airport Police or the aircraft crew.
