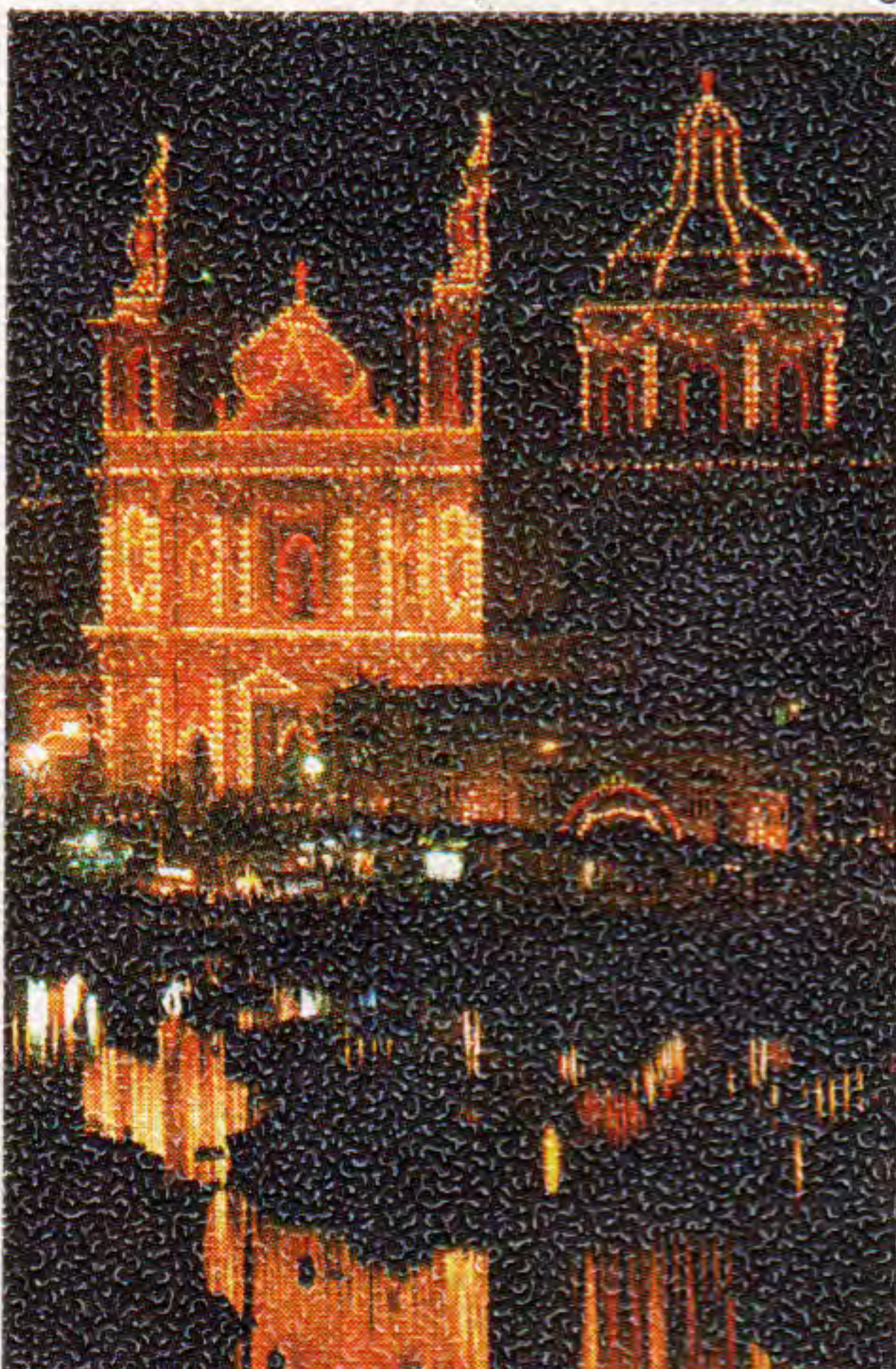

Club Class – more than a touch of class

Principal Events in Malta and Gozo

March 23-30 – Mediterranean Folk Festival: Folk groups from Mediterranean countries join Maltese folk dancers and singers in a grand manifestation of Mediterranean folk traditions. This is the major folk reunion in the Mediterranean.

March 22-25 – International Festival of Maltese Song: This festival, recognised by the International Federation of Song Festivals, FIDOP, presents top Maltese singers and top singers from at least twelve other countries in the interpretation of the best Maltese compositions in the pop-song field. Songs are interpreted on a competitive basis in the Maltese and foreign versions in the first two nights, with a gala performance on the first night.

March 30-31 – Malta's National Day celebrates the departure of all armed foreign forces from the Island and the attainment of full freedom in peace on the 31st March 1979. Celebrated as the most important event in the cultural calendar, the programme includes outstanding outdoor and indoor popular theatre performances, parades, land and water sports, official ceremonies and colourful fireworks.

April 20 – Holy Week: Processions are held in the afternoon of **Good Friday** in 14 towns and villages. Life-size statues are carried in procession, with participants dressed in period costumes, depicting episodes from the Old Testament and from the life of Jesus.

April 22 – Easter Sunday: Morning processions with the statue of the Risen Christ are held in five towns and villages. The statue, accompanied by a brass band, is carried shoulder high by youths at a run. A festive atmosphere prevails during Easter morning.

April 25-28 – International Archery Tournament: Scores of participants from Eastern and Western European countries attend this event, always superbly organised.

May 11-13 – The three-day Carnival festivities, held mainly in Valletta, date back to as far as 1535, when the Knights of St. John introduced "Carnival" in Malta. This festival of fun includes dancing competitions in elaborate costumes, band marches, decorated trucks and grotesque masks. Special features are "Il-Parata" (a sword dance commemorating Malta's defeat of the besieging Turks in 1565), "Il-Maltija" (Malta's national dance), and other dances by companies in costume from a number of countries.

June 23-24 – "Mnarja" Folk Festival: This is an all-night traditional Maltese "festa" with folk music, dancing and impromptu Maltese folk singing. This folk-cum-harvest feast originated in the Middle Ages. The word "Mnarja" is derived from "luminarja" (lighting up), because on the eve and on the feast day itself, the countryside and bastions around Mdina, Malta's ancient capital, were illuminated by "fjakkoli" (torches made of sand mixed with oil and animal fat).

June 23-27 – The International Air Rally of Malta draws participants from all over Europe and the United States. The arrival of light aircraft taking part in 1984 – the 15th edition of the rally – will be spread over two days. Competition includes time arrival and a Concours d'Elegance.

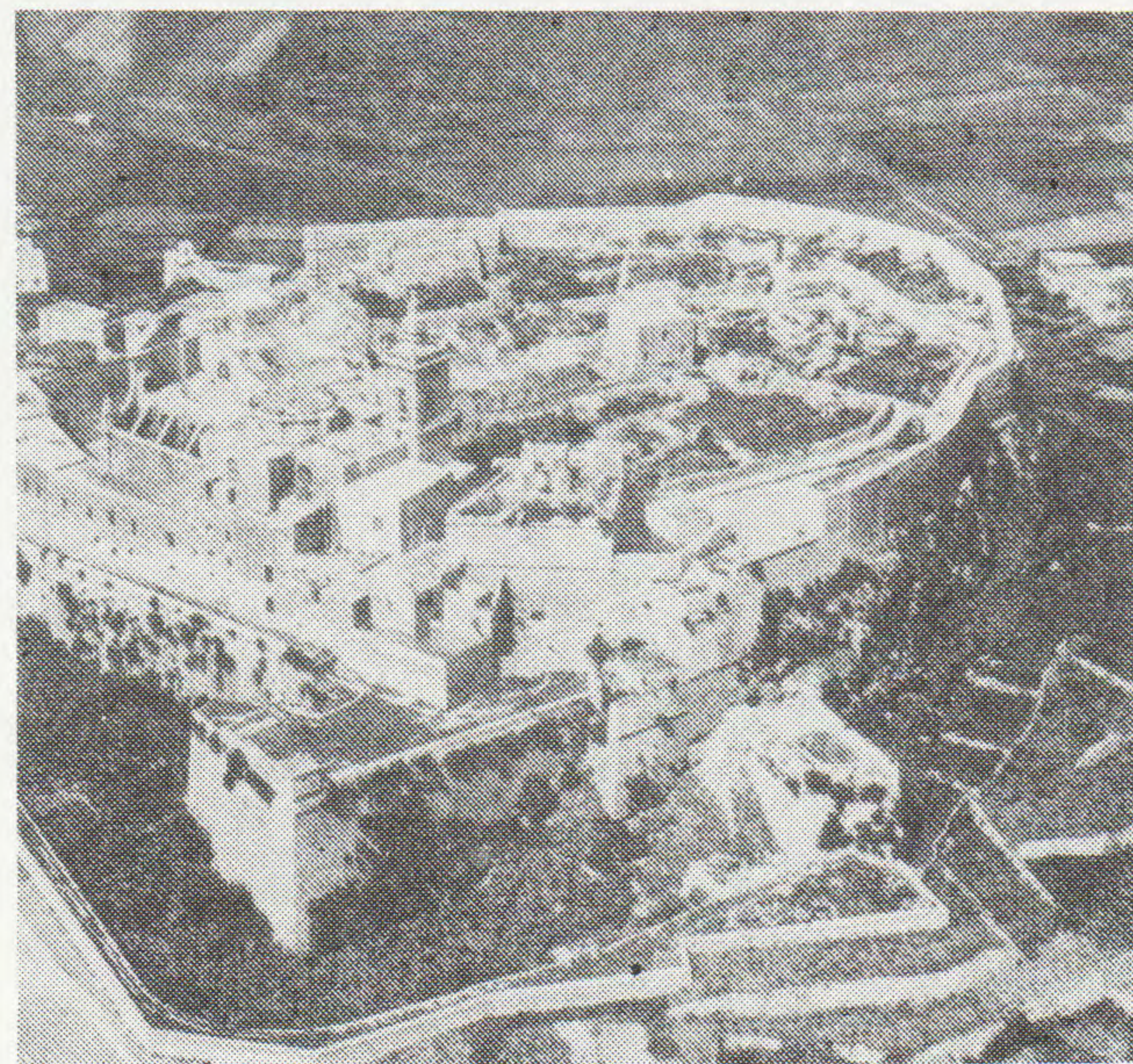
July 21-August 12 – MALTA FEST – the Maltese International Arts Festival: This festival is a celebration of the Arts in historic surroundings. Top local and foreign talent from the performing arts is presented at outdoor venues in major historic sites, such as the dance spectacles at the megalithic temple of Hagar Qim, music, choir singing and drama in the ancient capital Mdina, art exhibitions, and other art forms including popular modern music in Valletta and Sliema.

September 9: The commemoration of the **Two Sieges** is held during the first weekend of September. The Maltese commemorate the raising of two bitterly fought sieges – that of 1565 and that of 1940-43. On this day, centuries-old Regatta is held in the Grand Harbour, and it is one of the most popular of spectator sports.

October 6 – International yachting. The now famous **Martini Middle Sea Race** is in the Annual Calendar of Yacht Races for yachts in Class A and Classes I and V. This 1000 km race takes the yachts from Malta around Lampedusa, Pantelleria, Sicily and back. It is organised by the Valletta Yacht Club with the assistance of the Royal Ocean Racing Club. The Martini Middle Sea Race is the climax of a whole week of international yacht racing events in Malta.

December 13 – Republic Day: Festivities are organised to commemorate the promulgation of the 1st Maltese Constitution which set up the Republic. National competition for local talent (band music, choirs, ballet, dance) are organised as well as an outdoor parade at which the President of the Republic takes the salute of the representatives of all sectors of the working population.

December 18-January 1: Yuletide festivities.

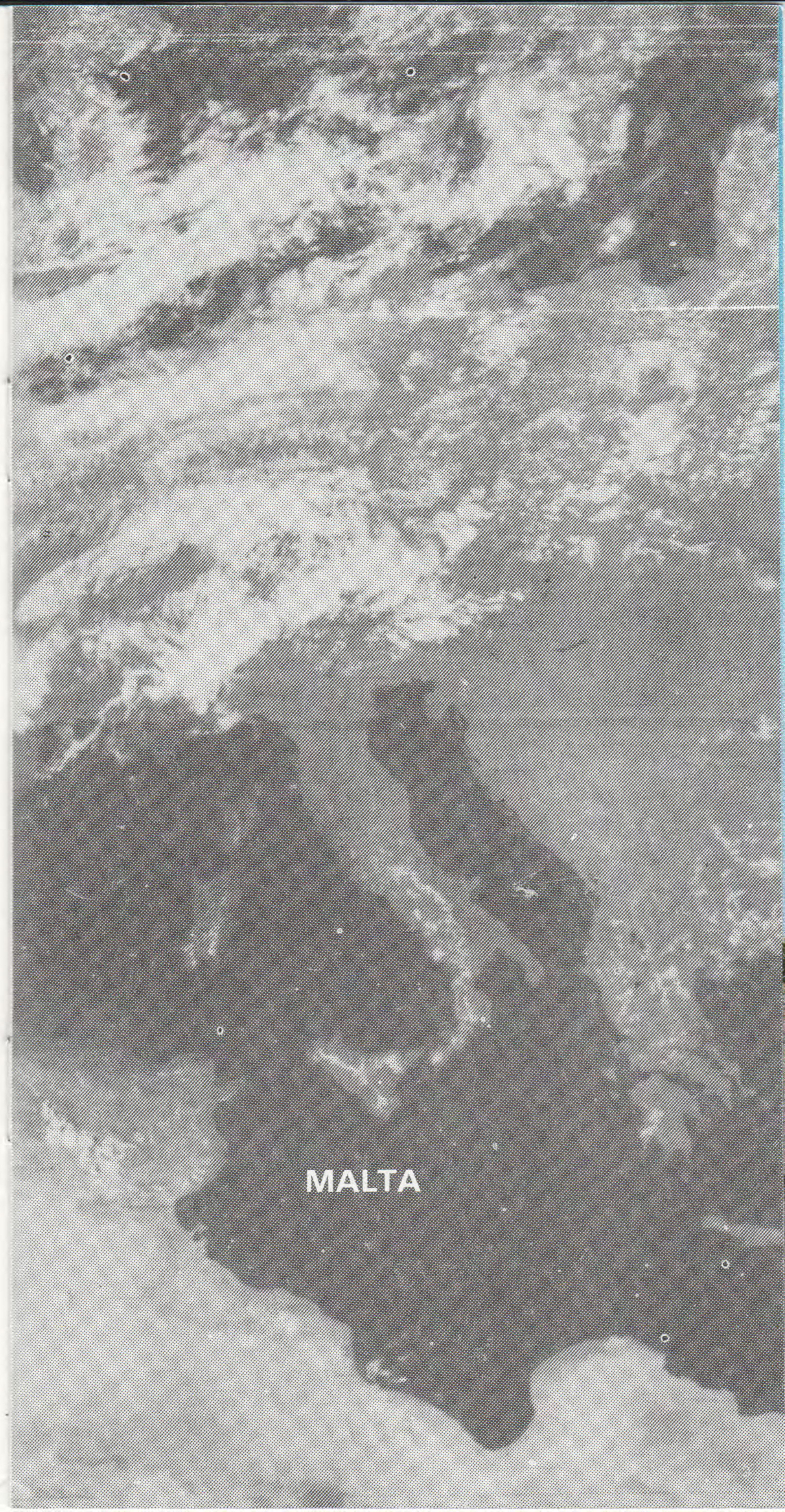

TIPS ON LUGGAGE

At AirMalta, we do all we can to make sure that our passengers and their baggage arrive on the same flight at the same time. To help us do even better, here are some tips to follow:

1. **Use a good quality bag** – Choose baggage of good quality – solidly constructed of material that won't split or tear and has strong seams, zippers and locks. Bags with wheels, pull straps or hooks should have those items removed prior to check in.
2. **Always lock your bag** – This reduces the chance that your baggage will accidentally pop open and discourages any unauthorized opening.
3. **Avoid overpacking your bags** – Pack only what your bag can comfortably hold. Overpacking can damage both your bags and their contents. Be particularly careful with canvas or soft-sided bags.
4. **Use external name tags** – Please help us comply with industry requirements by making sure that your personal identification is on the outside of each piece of luggage. We will be glad to offer you passenger identification tags free of charge. Be sure your name is also inside each bag.
5. **Keep your valuables with you** – Do not check medicines, important documents or business papers, passports, tourist cards, car or house keys, jewellery or other valuable items.
6. **Follow carry-on baggage rules** – Carry-on bags must fit underneath the seat in front of you.
7. **Allow plenty of time for check-in** – Plan to be at the airport for check-in at least one hour prior to schedule departure so that you can complete pre-departure check-in, customs and other formalities.
8. **Remove old destination tags** – To avoid any possible confusion, take off any tags from your previous trips.
9. **Monitor your baggage at check-in** – Double check to be sure that your baggage claim receipt shows your correct destination. Wait at the ticket counter to make sure that your bags have been tagged.
10. **Allow ample connecting time** – Trust the scheduling advice of your travel agent or AirMalta reservation agent. As efficient as airlines are, passengers can be connected more quickly than their bags, so allow plenty of time between flights.
11. **Be sure to reclaim your own bag** – When claiming your bag at your destination, do not simply rely on the colour or style. Match the number on your claim receipt with the number on the bag and double check your baggage ID tag before leaving the claim area.
12. **If you need assistance, see the Baggage Services agents immediately** – Baggage services personnel at airports are trained professionals at assisting passengers in solving any mishandling problems which might arise. The earlier that you ask for their assistance, the faster they can help resolve your problem.
