GENERAL PASSENGER INFORMATION

TIMETABLES AND FARES:—All times and fares shown are for information purposes only and are subject to change without notice.

EQUIPMENT:—Four-engine Douglas airliners are used on all flights.

FREE BAGGAGE ALLOWANCE:—Forty-four (44) pounds (20 kilograms) of baggage will be carried free on each international ticket covering travel entirely by air. Excess baggage will be accepted, space and weight permitting, and will be charged at the rate of ½ of 1% of the published one-way fare per pound, with a minimum charge of twenty-five cents (25c).

FLIGHT ATTENDANTS:—Courteous stewards and stewardesses on all flights are bilingual English and Spanish.

GROUND TRANSPORTATION:—Taxicab and limousine service is available between downtown areas, scheduled pick-up points and airport at passenger's expense.

RESERVATIONS:—All reservations must be made in advance and will be held only long enough to permit purchase of ticket as soon as practical after reservation of the originating portion has been confirmed at which time your specific ticket deadline is given.

PASSPORTS AND TOURIST CARDS:—U. S. citizens traveling to Mexico must have a Tourist Card. This may be obtained at any Mexican Tourist Bureau or Mexican consulate upon proper proof of U. S. citizenship. U. S. citizens do not need a passport. Citizens of other nationalities should consult the nearest consulate or official Tourist Bureau of the countries they propose to visit in order to obtain official advice.

CUSTOMS DUTIES:—International baggage will be examined by customs officers at each country upon arrival. Personal articles intended for use while travelling will be admitted duty-free. All other articles are subject to duty.

Residents of the United States are permitted to return to the U. S., duty-free, merchandise acquired outside the U. S. to the extent of (a) maximum of two hundred dollars (\$200.00) provided the passenger has been away from the U. S. for a period exceeding 48 hours (except Mexico where a 24-hour minimum time limit is prescribed) with only one such exemption being allowed within any single thirty (30) day period; or (b) a maximum of five hundred dollars (\$500.00) provided the passenger has been away from the U. S. for a period of not less than twelve (12) days with only one such exemption being allowed within any single six (6) month period.

CHILDREN AND INFANT FARES:—An infant under two years of age, when accompanied by an adult and not occupying a separate seat, is carried free. Children between two years of age and twelve years of age, or infants occupying a separate seat are carried at 50% of the published adult fare.

TAXES:—All taxes imposed by government authority are in addition to the transportation fare and will be collected whenever effective.

NEW REGULATIONS:—Effective July 1, 1952, a reconfirmation of your reservation will be required. The fact that you hold a ticket for a flight does not insure your seat being held for you unless you RE-CONFIRM YOUR RESERVATIONS. These re-confirmation regulations are being adopted by all SCHEDULED airlines in your interest. The procedure is as follows:

- * If you cannot give a telephone number at which you can be reached, then you must notify 12 hours before flight time and re-confirm that you will be using your reservation. If you do not, your reservations cannot be held for you.
- * If your itinerary within the U. S. includes a stopover of more than 12 hours in a city enroute, then you must notify and re-confirm your reservation at least 6 hours before departure from the stopover city.

CHECK-IN RULE:—Your reservations may be forfeited if you fail to present your ticket at the airport at least one hour before departure time in Mexico City. Government formalities make it necessary that you check-in at the airport at least 30 minutes before scheduled departure time of an international flight.
