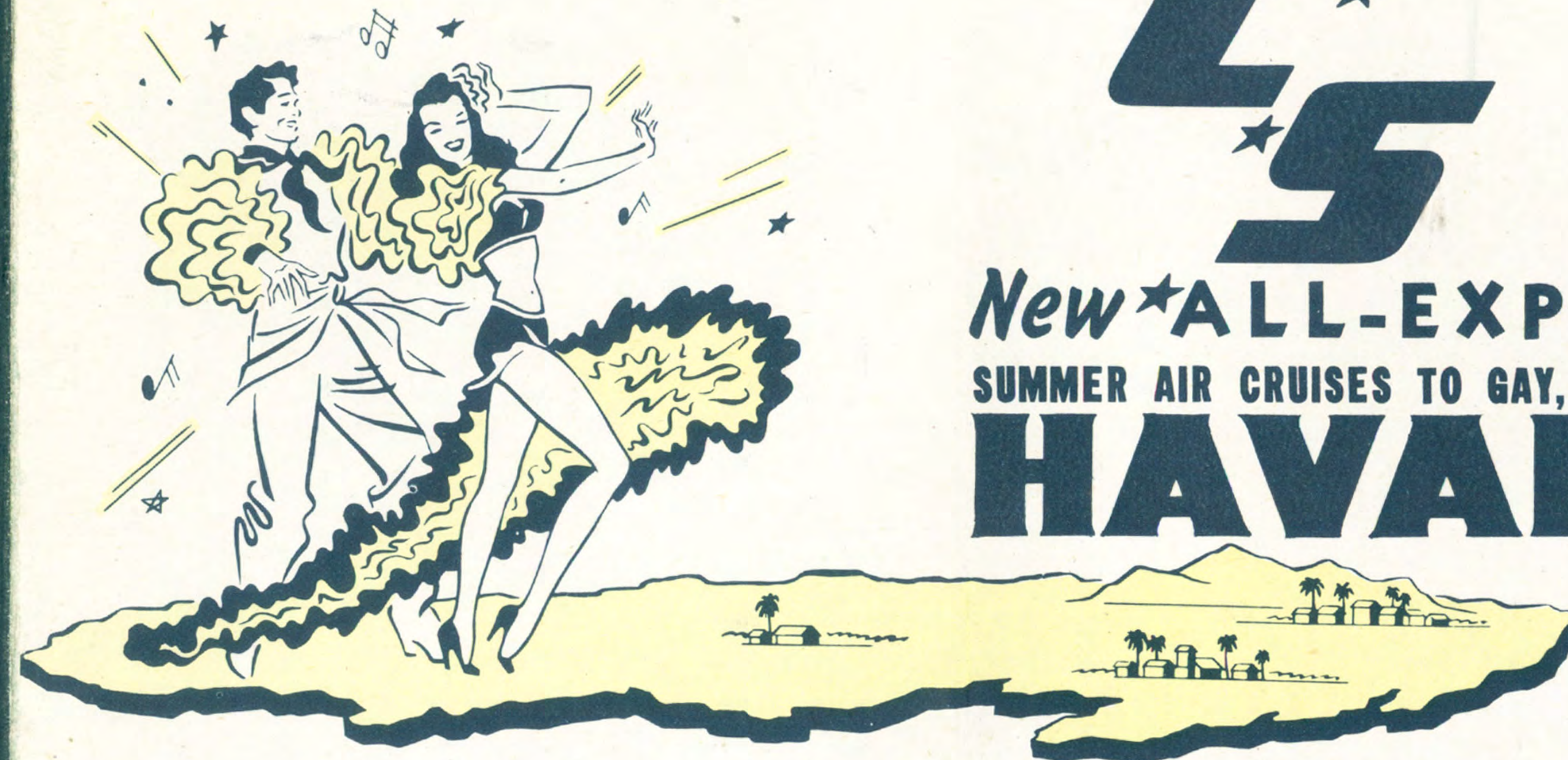

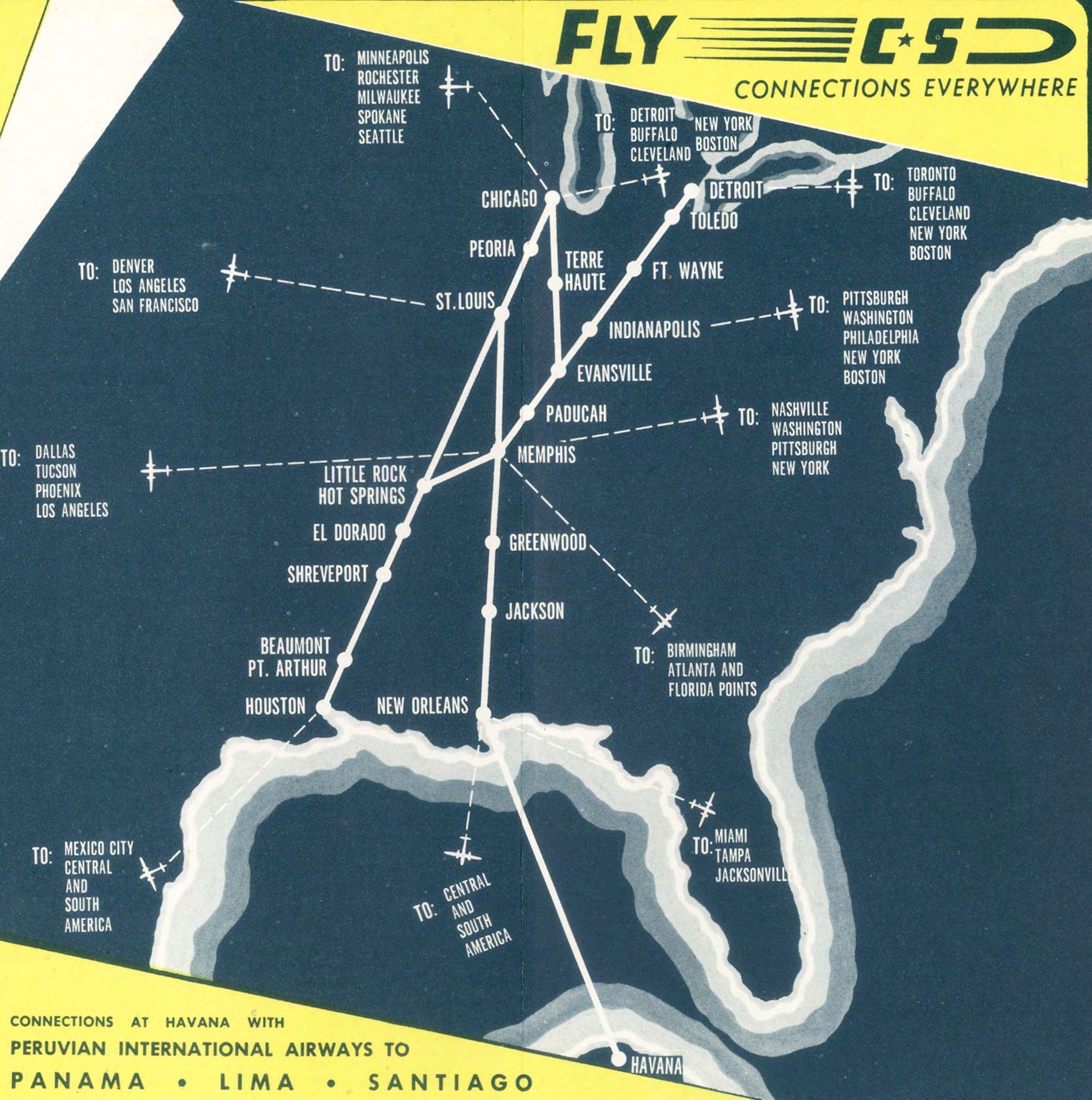

AIRFREIGHT and AIR EXPRESS carried on all flights. For information on domestic and international rates or service, contact Traffic Manager in above cities or write Cargo Traffic and Sales Manager, Memphis, Tenn.

BAGGAGE—Forty (40) pounds of baggage (66 pounds for Chicago and Southern Air Lines International travel) will be carried free on any ticket. Excess Baggage, Domestic and International, will be accepted upon special arrangement at the published rates. The liability of the Carrier, if any, for loss of or damage to baggage is limited to the actual value of such baggage, which is presumed not to exceed \$100.00 for each passenger, unless a higher valuation is declared and an additional charge paid therefor. Baggage weight charges are separate and distinct from baggage valuation charges.

CHILDREN—Babies under 2 years old carried free when accompanied by a full fare passenger. Half fare for children under 12 years of age via Chicago and Southern Air Lines, Inc. (for International travel see tariff).

EQUIPMENT—4 Engine Douglas DC-4, 50 passenger and Douglas DC-3, 21 passenger planes. DC-4 equipment used on flights indicated by symbol (●).

GROUND TRANSPORTATION—Chicago and Southern Air Lines has arranged ground transportation facilities for the convenience of its passengers. The company itself does not operate such service. Passengers using their own ground transportation direct to the airport are requested to report to the Ticket Agent at least twenty (20) minutes before Dixieliner departure time.

INTERNATIONAL REQUIREMENTS—It will be the passengers' responsibility to possess valid passports and/or other documents required by the Governmental Agencies involved.

PASSAGE, CANCELLATION BY COMPANY—The Company may cancel any reservation if the person holding the reservation has not presented himself at the airport ticket office for the purpose of checking in at least ten minutes prior to the scheduled departure time of the flight for which the reservation was made. The company reserves the right to cancel booking before passage or en route. Pilot may remove passengers from plane or refuse them admittance to plane at any point on the route for safety or other cause. In all events the passenger's sole recourse shall be recovery of that portion of the fare equal to the distance untraveled.

PASSAGE, CANCELLATION BY PASSENGER—Reservations must be cancelled prior to scheduled departure time if full refund is desired.

RESERVATIONS—Since all seats are reserved, passengers are urged to make reservations well in advance. Reservations are tentative until tickets have been purchased.

TICKETS—All-year Domestic, valid for 120 days from date of issuance. All-year International, valid for 1 year from date of commencement of passage from point of origin. For validity of excursion tickets see applicable tariff.

STOP-OVERS—Stop-overs will be permitted at any regular stop provided reservation is made accordingly.

TIME-TABLES—These time-tables show the times at which planes may be expected to depart from and arrive at the several stations shown, but are subject to change without notice, and are not guaranteed.

PLANE FACTS

Q. How do I make an airline reservation?

A. Simply call the local office of Chicago and Southern. Tell the reservation agent where you want to go and how many people will be included. He will handle the rest and give you **immediate** confirmation. If your destination is not on the C & S System, he will make reservations for you with the correct airline.

Q. When should reservations be made?

A. Make your reservation as far in advance as possible, in person or by telephone, and try to pick up your tickets early. If you change plans, don't forget to cancel your reservation. If you don't, some other passenger may not be able to secure a seat. When you make the proper cancellations and free your seat for another traveler, you are giving him and the airline the cooperation that will enable C & S to accommodate you and others at all times.

Q. Where do I pick up my tickets?

A. Chicago and Southern maintains conveniently-located downtown ticket offices in most of the cities on its system. In smaller cities, tickets may be picked up at the airport.

Q. How do I reach the airport?

A. At the time you make reservations you will be asked whether you wish transportation to the airport. If you do, C & S has made arrangements for transportation to the airport from the major hotels. The rates are usually from 50 cents to one dollar. When you reach your destination, transportation will be waiting to take you downtown.

Q. What do I do on reaching the airport?

A. Be sure to check in at the C & S ticket office there before boarding your plane. The agent there will give you final boarding information.

Q. How much luggage am I allowed to take on the plane?

A. Forty pounds of luggage may be carried free on your ticket. This is quite a bit more than the average well-packed suitcase. Additional luggage will be carried at nominal rates per pound. More liberal allowances are made for international passengers. Incidentally, once you reach the ticket office or the terminal, the airline takes over your luggage

and it is weighed and checked before you leave and delivered to you when you reach your destination.

Q. Is my seat reserved when traveling Chicago and Southern?

A. Our confirmation of your reservation request is your assurance of a seat to your destination. When you get on the plane, you are entitled to any empty seat except those tagged "OCCUPIED," which we are holding for passengers who have boarded at preceding stations.

Q. What dining service is provided when I travel by air?

A. Chicago and Southern provides delicious meals at appropriate hours. Breakfast, lunch, and dinner are all served piping hot from our modern galleys with our compliments. Beverages and between-meal snacks are also provided.

Q. Is there a washroom aboard the plane?

A. A completely equipped washroom is at your disposal.

Q. Can my baby come with me when I travel C & S?

A. Of course! Air travel is ideal for babies. You eliminate those bothersome overnight journeys. And the C & S stewardess is always ready to help with conveniences such as warming the baby's bottle. What's more, babies under two can ride free on every adult ticket—one baby per adult ticket.

Q. Who makes up the crew?

A. On all C & S planes, the crew consists of a pilot, co-pilot, and stewardess. These people have been trained most thoroughly at our special training schools. Periodically they are given refresher courses and are constantly kept abreast of new aviation developments. Many of our pilots have flown over a million miles, and all are experts in such matters as flight planning, weather observation, radio control, navigation, and instrument flying. Stewardesses are completely schooled in the art of preparing and serving meals, helping with children, and dispensing information. They are with us to help YOU.

Q. Where do I claim my luggage at my destination?

A. Chicago and Southern porters will have your luggage at the limousine loading point a few minutes after you land.
