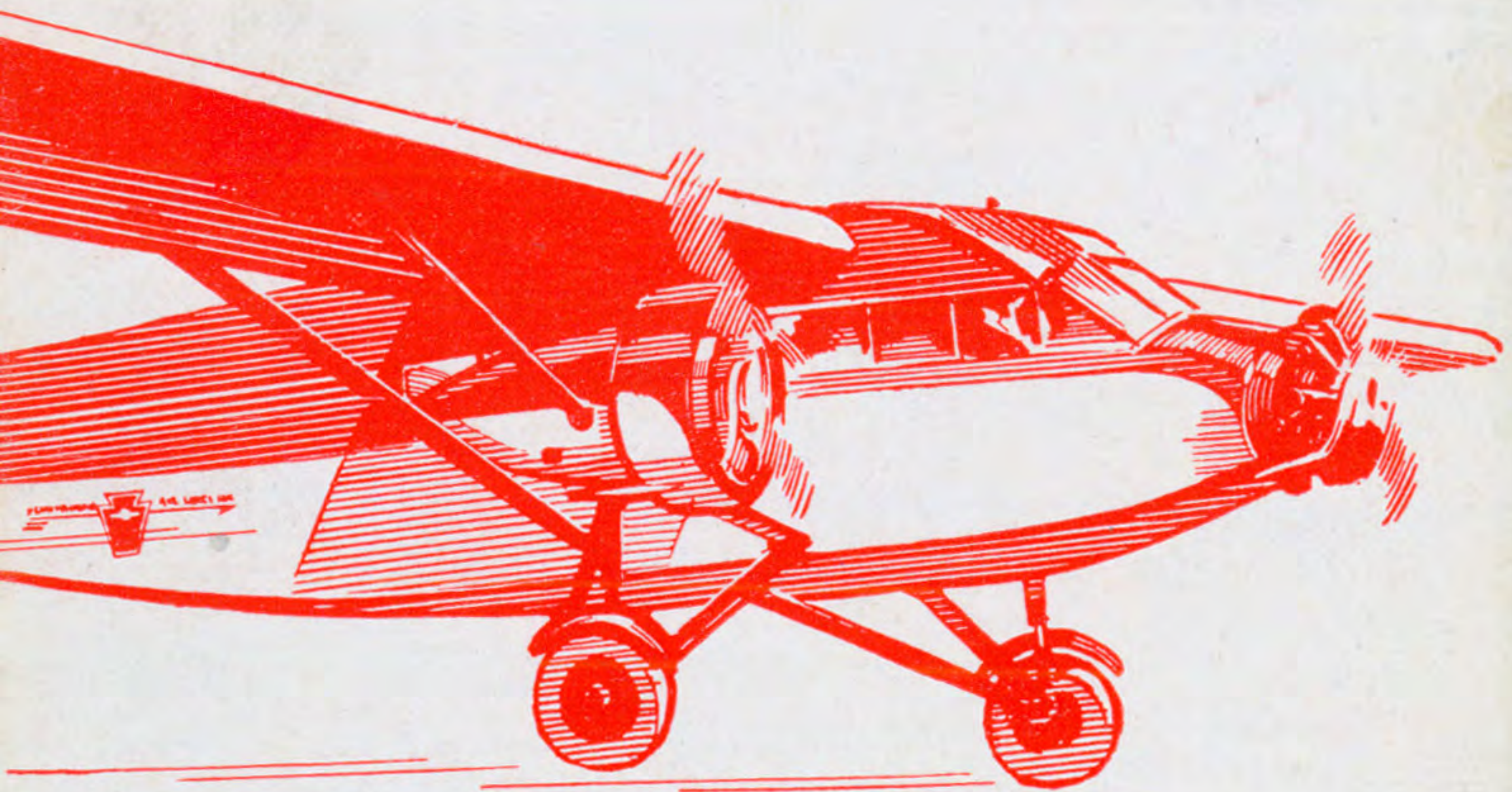

GENERAL INFORMATION

Air Mail... Pennsylvania Airlines is a U. S. Government Air Mail Contractor. Air mail is carried on all trips.

Air Express... Air express can be shipped on all Pennsylvania Airlines planes. New low rates are available, with optional pick-up and delivery service by the Postal Telegraph Company. For complete information phone or call any Pennsylvania Airlines or Postal Telegraph office.

Baggage... Thirty (30) pounds of baggage will be carried free. Excess baggage, if allowed, will be charged for per pound at the rate of 1/2 of 1% (1/2%) of the passenger fare, with a minimum charge of 25 cents.

Equipment... Tri-motored 9 Passenger Transport Planes equipped with two-way radio and toilet facilities.

Passage... (Cancellation—Refunds—Refusal of)—The company reserves the right to cancel bookings, or to terminate flights, enroute because of weather or other conditions. In such case a full refund equivalent to the unused portion of the ticket will be made. Passengers cancelling reservations will receive a full refund on tickets purchased, if notice of cancellation is given two hours before the scheduled departure of the plane for which ticket is issued.

Reservation... All seats are held by reservation. Reservations are not valid until the full purchase price has been paid. Bookings may be made through any Pennsylvania Airlines agent, all Postal Telegraph and Western Union offices, and the leading hotels and travel bureaus.

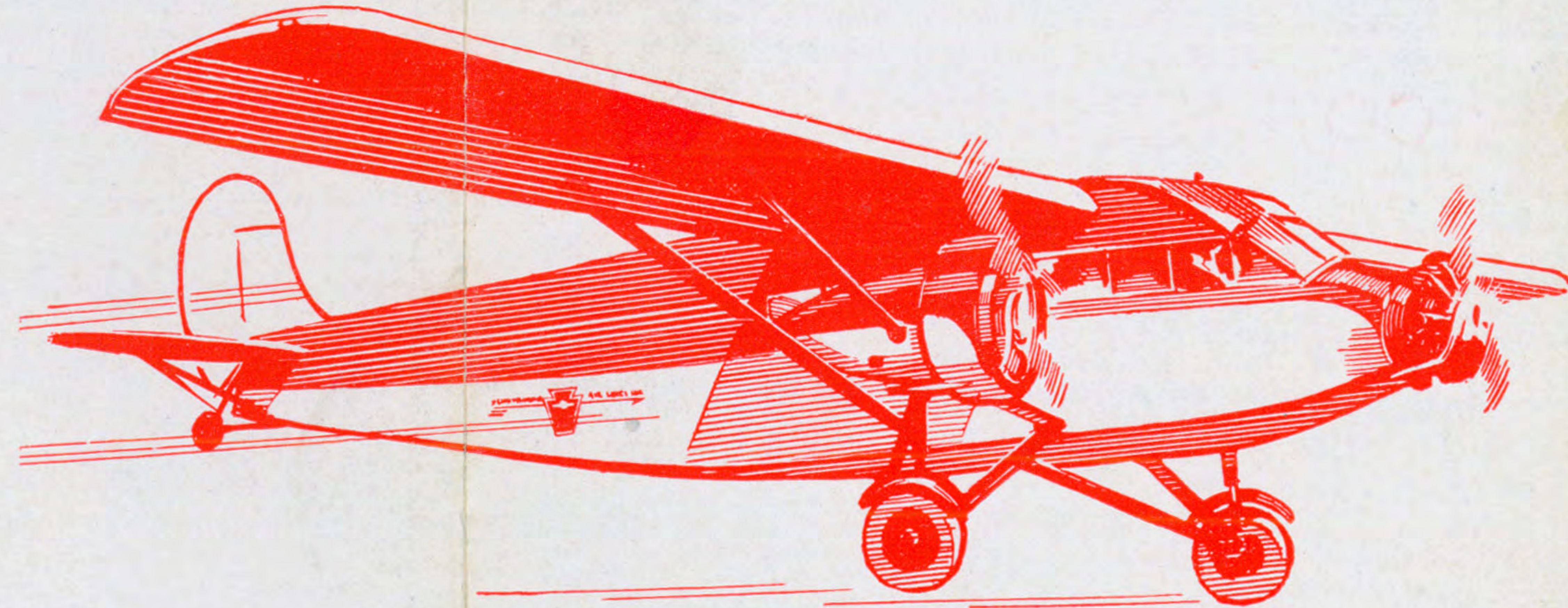
