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● RULES & REGULATIONS ●

RESERVATIONS Alpha Air does not intentionally overbook its flights. However overbooking may result due to substitution of equipment of smaller capacity or error. Alpha Air is exempt from paying Denied Boarding Compensation. If a flight is overbooked Alpha Air will deny boarding in accordance with its boarding priorities available at the ticket counter. You may purchase your ticket in advance at a Alpha Air ticket counter. Any travel agent can also ticket you on Alpha Air. Ticketed passengers must check in 15 minutes prior to scheduled departure time or reservation is subject to cancellation and resale to standby passengers.

PAYMENT Major credit cards are welcome. Alpha Air honors American Express, Mastercard, Visa, Diners Club, and JCB. Absolutely no personal checks or money orders accepted.

CHILDREN Children ages 2-12 fly for 15% off the regular S-coach fare. Children who have not yet reached their 2nd birthday travel free when carried on the lap of an accompanying adult.

HOLIDAY SCHEDULES Since holiday schedules differ, please call Alpha Air Reservations for this information.

FARE INCREASES Due to increases in operational costs, fares may be increased on short notice. Tickets purchased before the fare increases will be honored.

TICKET REFUND Tickets purchased from other airlines or travel agents must be refunded by issuing party. Tickets purchased from Alpha Air may be mailed to the corporate office for a refund. Please allow four weeks for processing of refund.

LOST TICKETS A passenger who loses a ticket, or a portion of a ticket, will be required to purchase another ticket at the appropriate fare before transportation between the applicable points will be furnished. There will be no refund for a lost ticket.

CHARTER Alpha Air provides charter flights for passengers and/or freight to any airport in the United States. Call for information and prices.

BAGGAGE To assist us in properly handling your baggage, we ask that you help us by observing the following:

1. For travel within the United States, the following pieces of baggage will be carried free, provided that no single piece weighs more than 40 pounds.

(a) One piece with total outside dimensions not exceeding 82 inches (L+W+H).

(b) One piece with total outside dimensions not exceeding 55 inches (L+W+H).

(c) Carry-on — Absolutely no carry-on baggage.

2. Passenger name identification must be placed on the outside of all baggage.

3. LIABILITY for baggage will not exceed \$750.00 per full fare passenger unless you declare a higher valuation and ship as cargo. If baggage is interlined to another airline, the lowest maximum liability per full fare passenger will be applied.

4. EXCLUSIONS: Alpha Air will not be responsible for loss or damage to jewelry, negotiable items, currency, antiques, radios, tape and video equipment, cameras, perishables and fragile items. This list is by illustration and not by limitation. Alpha Air will not be responsible for normal baggage wear and tear.

5. RESTRICTED ARTICLES & corrosive liquids, flammable substances, such as matches and lighter fluid, compressed gas, or any hazardous material may not be carried in baggage.

6. For further information please refer to airline's Contract of Carriage available at the ticket counter.

RESPONSIBILITY FOR DEPARTURES, ARRIVALS, CONNECTIONS Alpha Air will not be responsible for damages resulting from failure of flights to depart or arrive at times stated in this timetable, nor for errors herein, nor for failure to make connections with planes of other lines or of the Company. Schedules subject to change without notice. Schedules shown are based on expected flying times. Because weather and other factors may affect operating conditions, departure and arrival times cannot be guaranteed.

INTERLINE AND JOINT FARES Because Alpha Air participates in interline agreements with most air carriers, you and your baggage can be ticketed straight through to your final destination.
