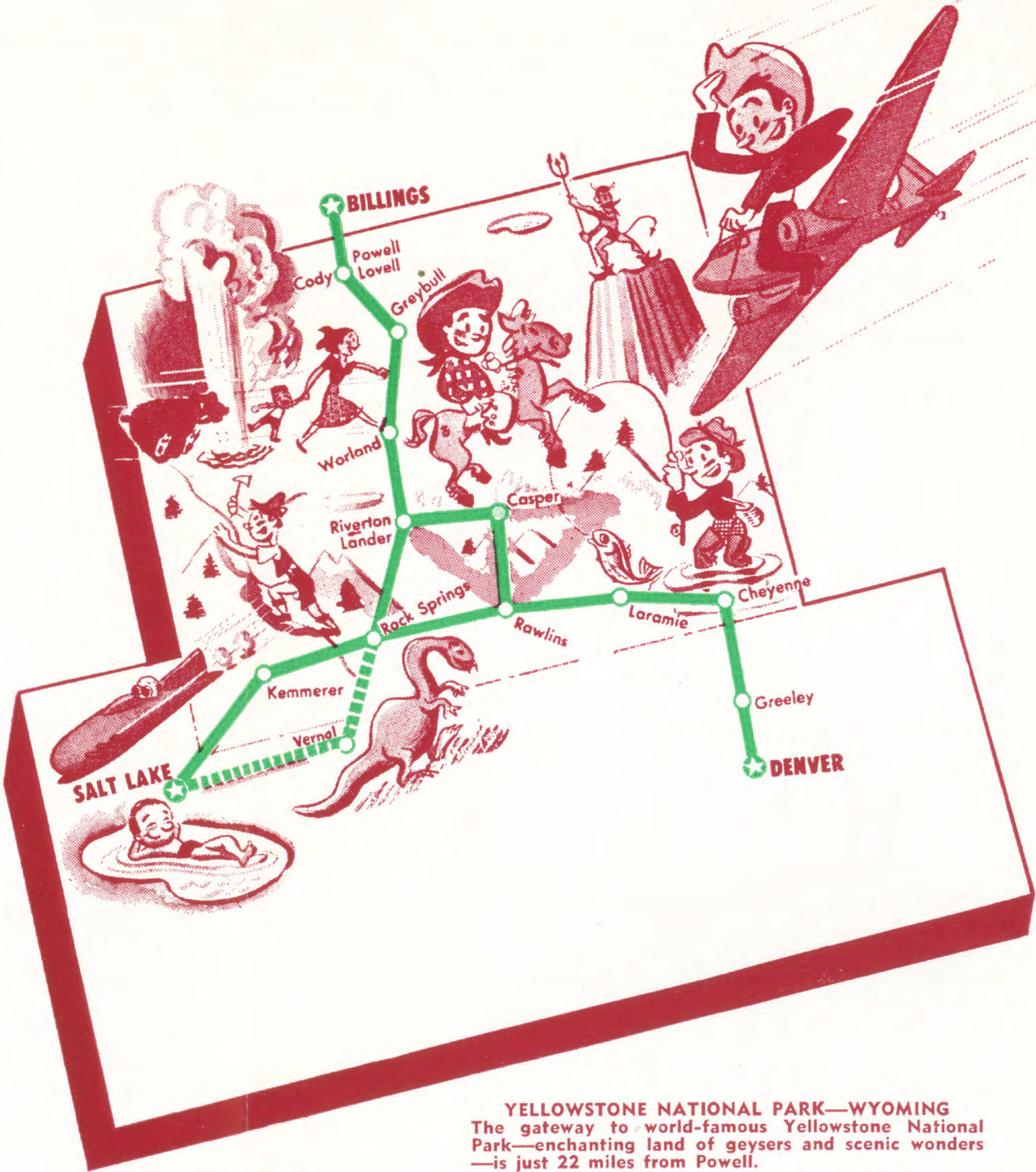

GENERAL INFORMATION

Air reservations to any destination in the United States or the world can be made at your nearest CHALLENGER ticket office or travel agency. Reservations are made and through tickets sold to any city in the United States served by government-authorized, scheduled air carriers. Universal Air Travel cards are gladly honored. Trip Insurance is available at all airline offices at new low rates.

RESERVATIONS

Reservations must be made in advance as all seats are reserved. After reservation requests are confirmed, tickets should be purchased a reasonable time in advance of flight departure. Passengers are requested to be at the airport at least 30 minutes before departure time.

STOPOVERS

Stopovers, within the time limits of tickets, will be permitted at any scheduled stop, providing previous arrangements have been made at the point of origin.

FARES AND SCHEDULES

Fares and schedules are subject to change without notice. The companies reserve the right to cancel flights before passage or en route whenever such action is deemed advisable. Challenger Airlines shall not be responsible for failure of aircraft to depart or arrive on schedule, or failure to make connections.

CHILDREN

One child under two years of age, not occupying a seat, will be carried free with each accompanying passenger 12 years of age or over. Children two years of age or under 12 years of age will be carried for half fare. Unaccompanied children under eight years of age will not be accepted for passage. On Monday, Tuesday, and Wednesday, a wife and all children through age 21 will be carried for half fare, if husband pays full fare.

AIRPLANES

On all flights you enjoy the comfort of modern twin-engined Douglas DC-3 planes. Flight crews, ground crews, and maintenance of planes are unexcelled in the United States.

BAGGAGE

Forty pounds of personal baggage will be carried free on each ticket. Baggage in excess of 40 pounds may be carried at published excess rates. Liability for baggage and personal property is limited to \$100.00 unless a higher valuation is declared and an additional charge paid.
